**TRIP PACKING INFORMATION**

For your information and convenience, we are listing some things to keep in mind and items to take along for your trip to camp.

Temperatures at camp average 10° F cooler than temperatures in our area. Please bear this in mind, especially when packing your clothing. It is a good practice to dress in layers of warm clothing rather than one heavy layer. Comfortable, practical clothes are recommended. Footwear must be warm, sturdy, and waterproof if possible. *Students should not bring or wear expensive jewelry or expensive belongings.*

The camp and Bridgewater-Raritan Middle School are not responsible for any damage or loss of personal items; therefore, limit what you bring to essentials only. **Name tags on personal items are recommended** (and should include name, school, and homeroom).
